7 Policy Title Statement of Guiding Principles Code No. 1000

10 It shall be the policy of the board of trustees to keep the community informed of the
11 objectives, achievements, needs, and conditions of the school system. The
12 superintendent shall be responsible for initiating and administrating a continuous
13 program of communications within the community. He/she shall utilize needed school
14 personnel and all media available in discharging this responsibility.

16 LEGAL PROVISIONS AND BOARD POLICY

18 1. There are no specific statutes in the Idaho Code pertaining to the absolute or
19 restricted use of public school buildings. The board of trustees shall make all
20 rules and regulations pertaining to the use of school facilities for civic meetings or
21 recreational activities.
22
23 2. Building and grounds may be rented to philanthropic groups and to organizations
24 that operate for the betterment of the community. The school facilities of the
25 district are recognized as belonging to the community and should be used to
26 stimulate and improve the cultural and economic condition within the community.
27
28 3. The instructional program and special school related activities have priority in the
29 use of the facilities at all times.
30
31 4. Tax revenues are provided for the regular instructional program and are not
32 sufficient to grant the use of school facilities to other groups without
33 compensation. Rental fees represent a token payment to the district for
34 maintenance and operation costs created by the additional use of the facilities.
