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7 Policy Title Emergency Administration of Medication Code No. 504.91

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10 Students who require emergency medication to treat life threatening medical conditions
11 may carry their medication with them and self-administer in accordance with district
12 procedures.

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14 In case of life threatening medical conditions, a school nurse or designee may
15 administer emergency oral, rectal, and/or injectable medication to any student in need
16 thereof on the school grounds, or in the school building, according to the standing order
17 of the district physician or the student's private physician.

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19 In the absence of a school nurse, an administrator or designated staff member who has
20 completed training in assisting with medication, may give emergency medication to
21 students. There must be on record a diagnosed medical condition that requires prompt
22 treatment to protect the student from serious harm or death.

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24 Student health and safety is a primary concern of all employees. It is district procedure
25 to have medications kept and dispensed in the nurse's office. Students with special
26 health needs may carry and/or self-administer emergency medication for life threatening
27 conditions in accordance with Idaho Code and district procedure governing the use of
28 self-administered emergency medications.
