Joint School District No. 2 and the board of trustees acknowledges that the 11 feeding of children is primarily a family responsibility. To supplement their efforts, every 12 school will operate a school nutrition program to ensure that all students have affordable 13 access to the varied and nutritious foods they need to stay healthy and learn well. 14 15 PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS. During each regular school day the school nutrition 16 program will offer breakfast and lunch to all students as well as break meals/snacks for 17 the secondary school. Each school will make all students aware of these meal 18 opportunities. In particular, the school will make efforts to ensure that families are aware 19 of need-based programs for free or reduced-priced meals and that eligible families are 20 encouraged to apply. The program will maintain the confidentiality of students and 21 families applying for or receiving free and reduced-priced meals. 22 23 The school nutrition program will operate in accordance with the National School Lunch 24 Act and the Child Nutrition Act of 1996 as amended and applicable laws and regulations 25 of Idaho. Schools will offer varied and nutritious food choices that are consistent with 26 the federal government's Dietary Guidelines for Americans. 27 28 Upon a physician's written request, modified meals will be prepared for students with food allergies or other special food needs.
