During the freshman and sophomore years students learn how to create formal application documents, such as:

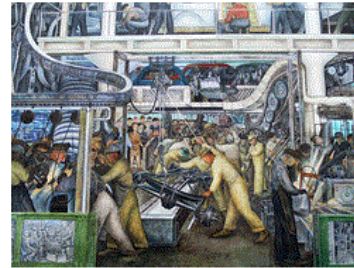
- Information requests

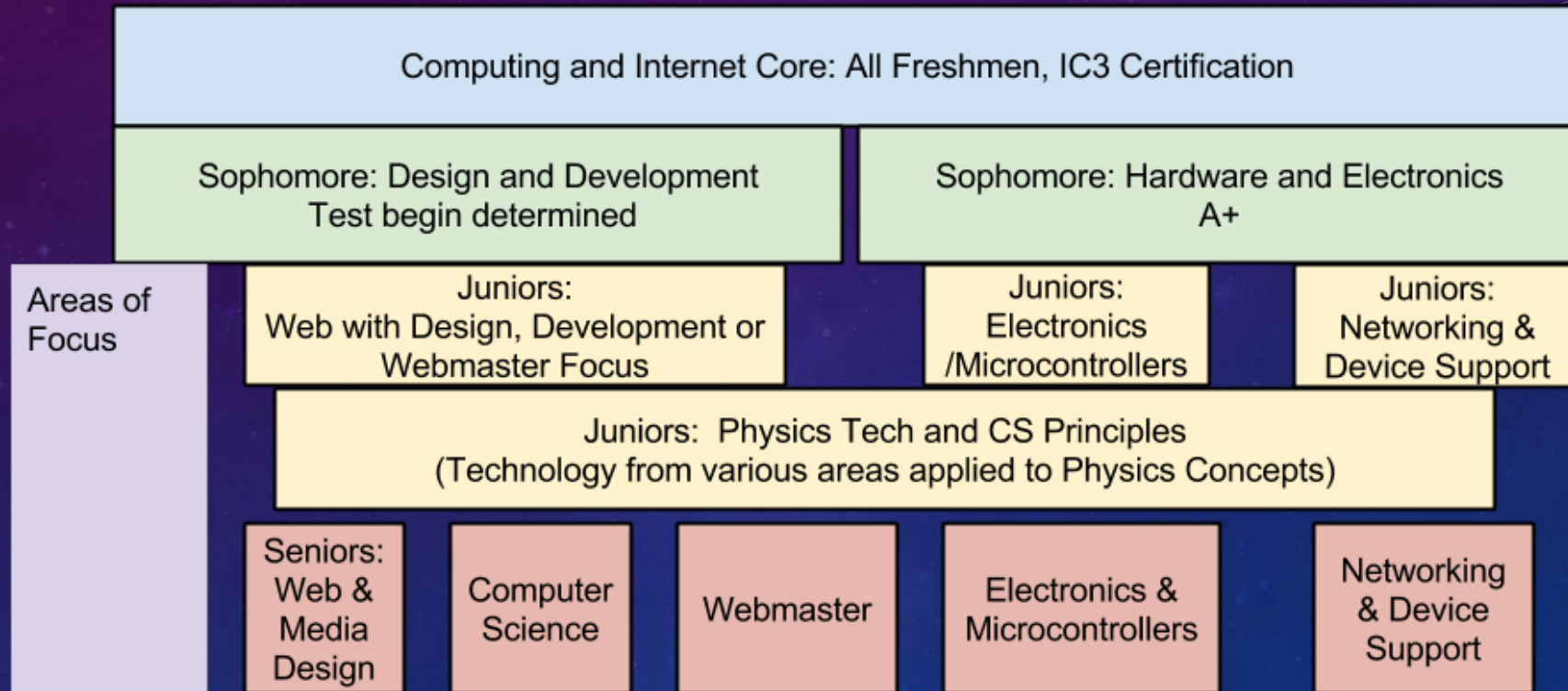

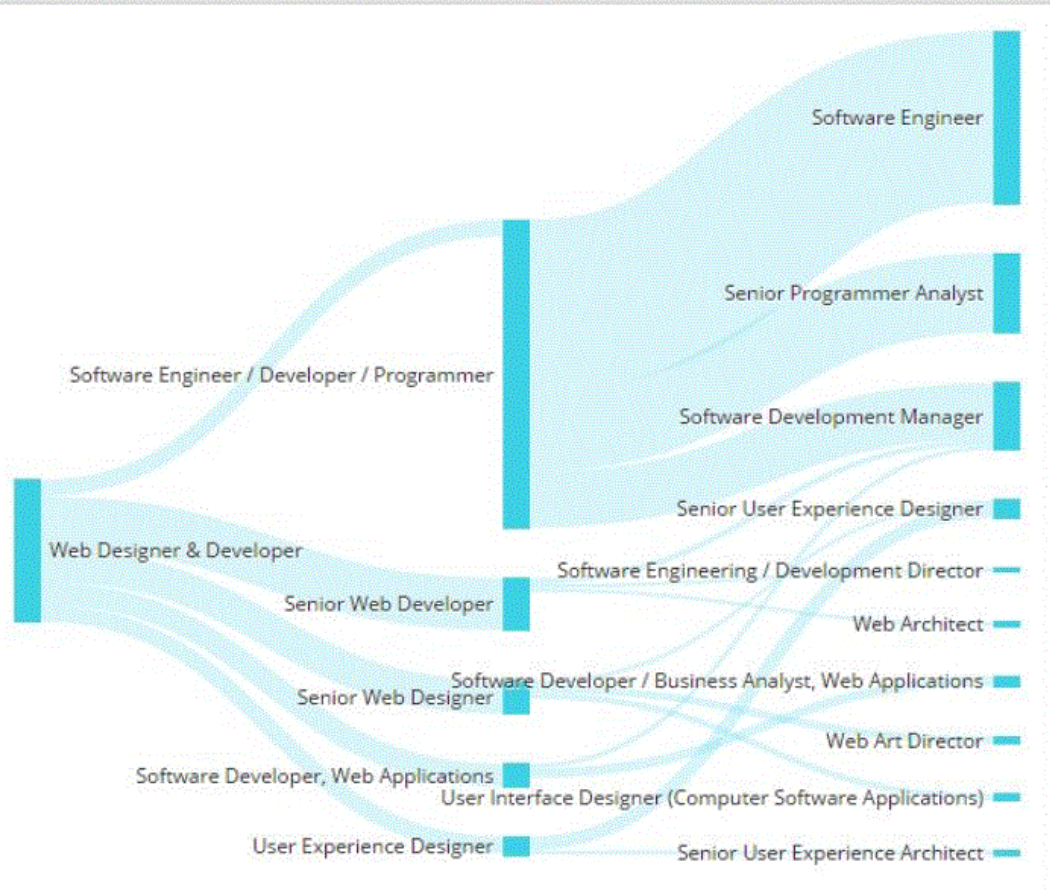

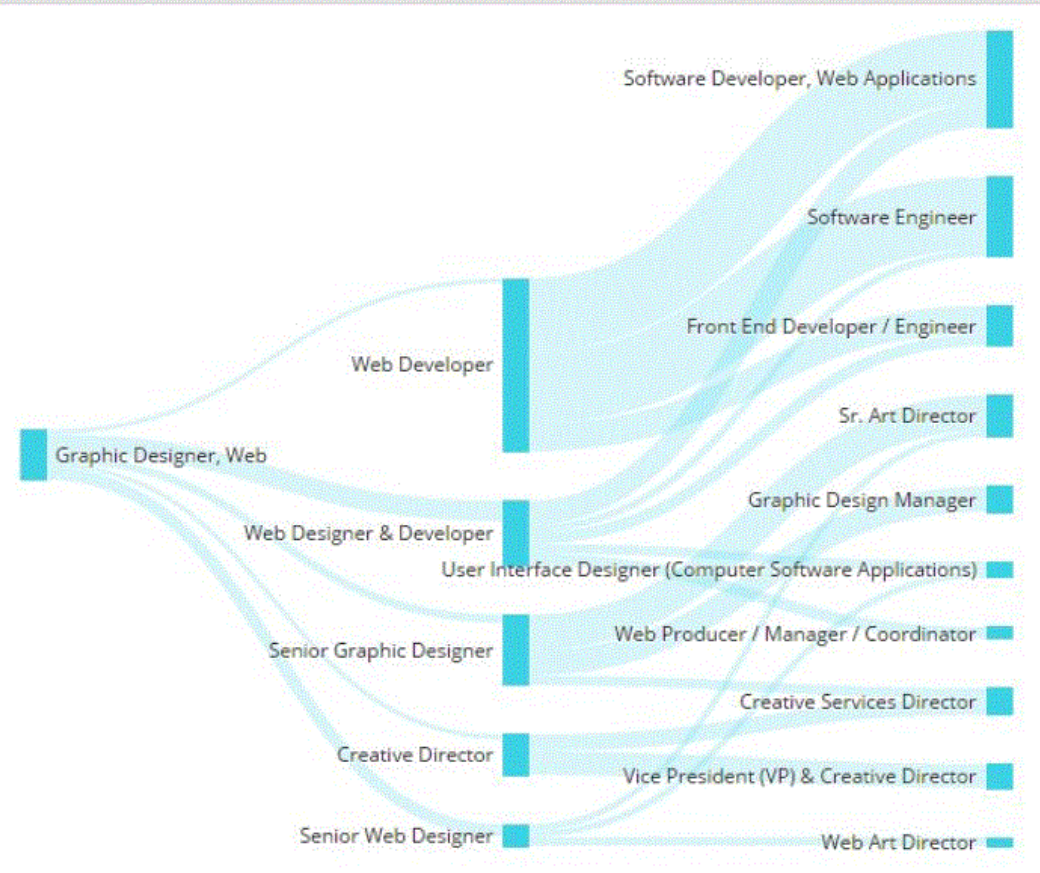

Common Career Paths for Web Designer & Developer



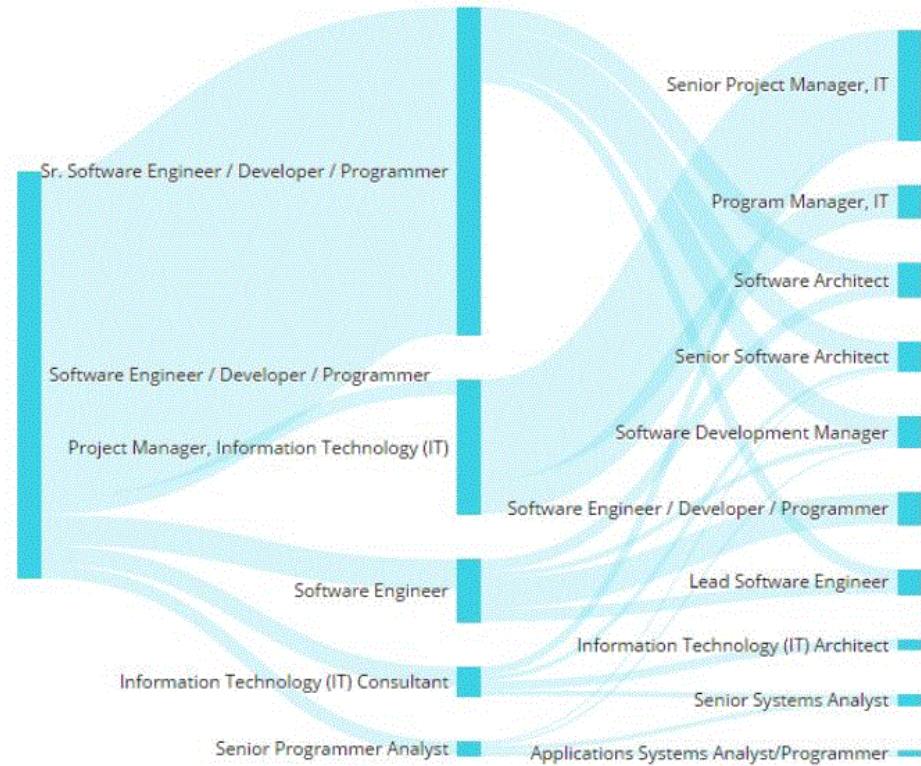
# Web and Media Design

Common Career Paths for Graphic Designer, Web



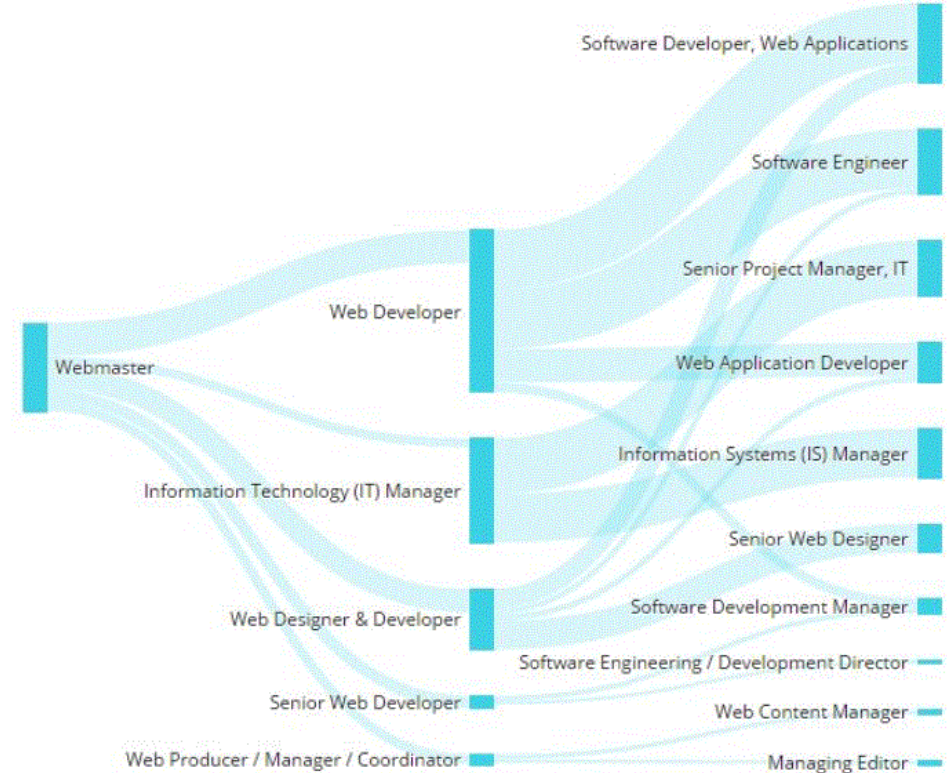

Common Career Paths for Software Engineer / Developer / Programmer



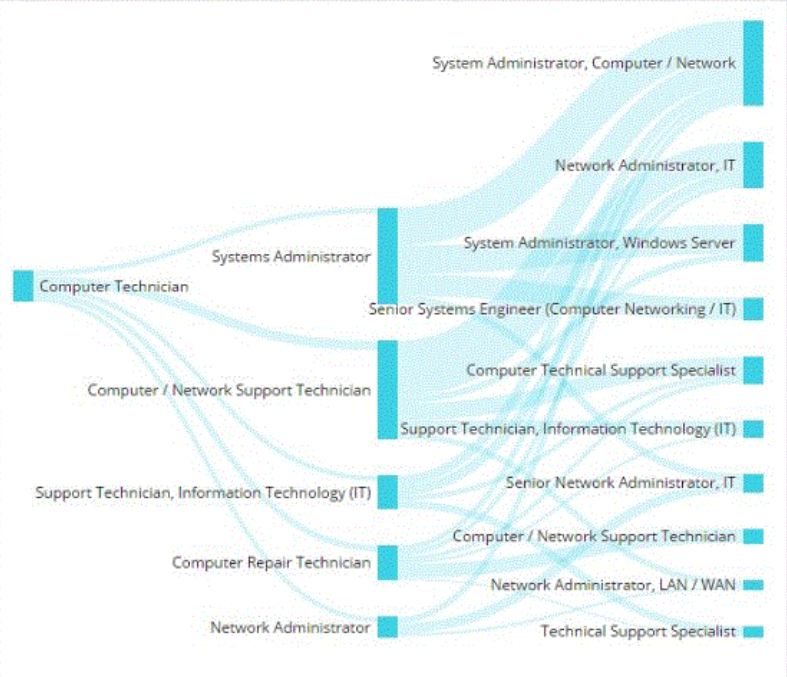

Common Career Paths for Webmaster

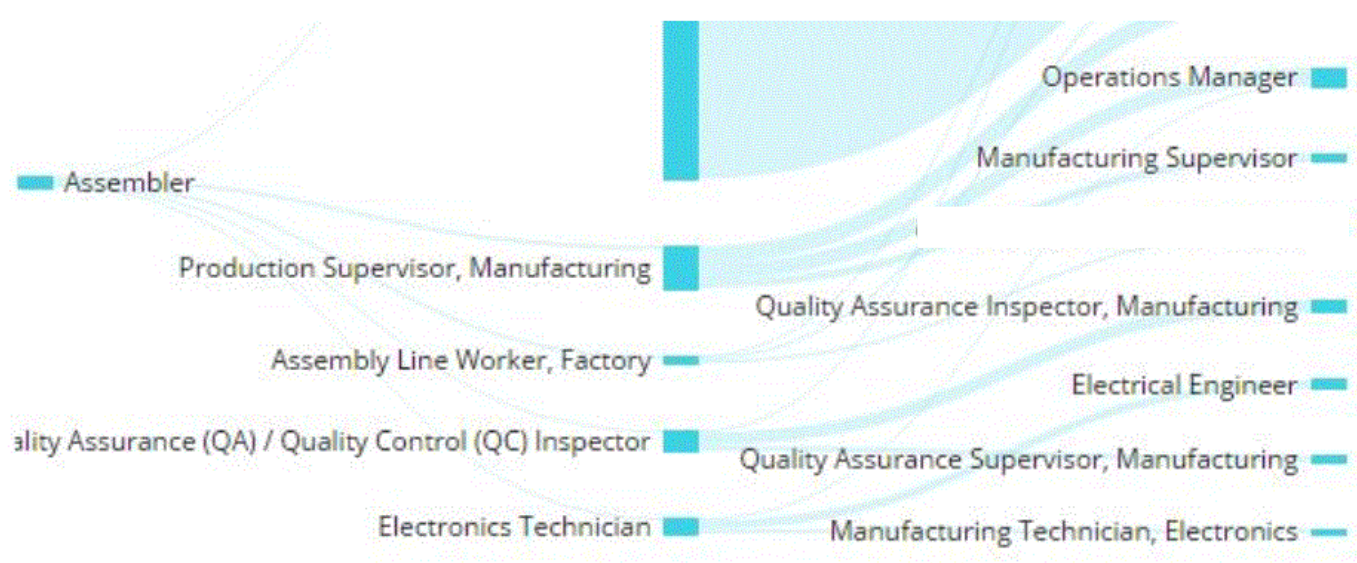

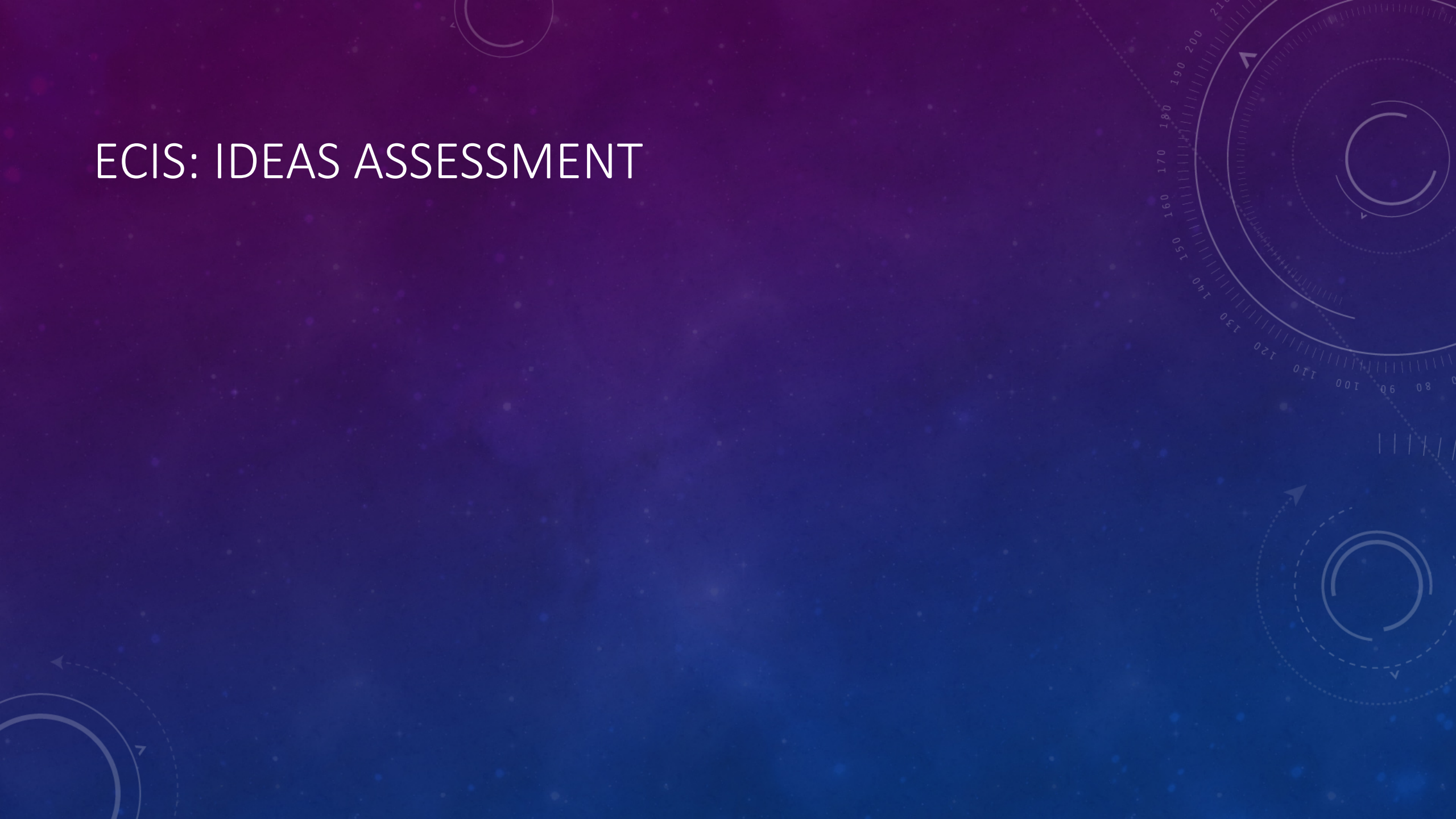

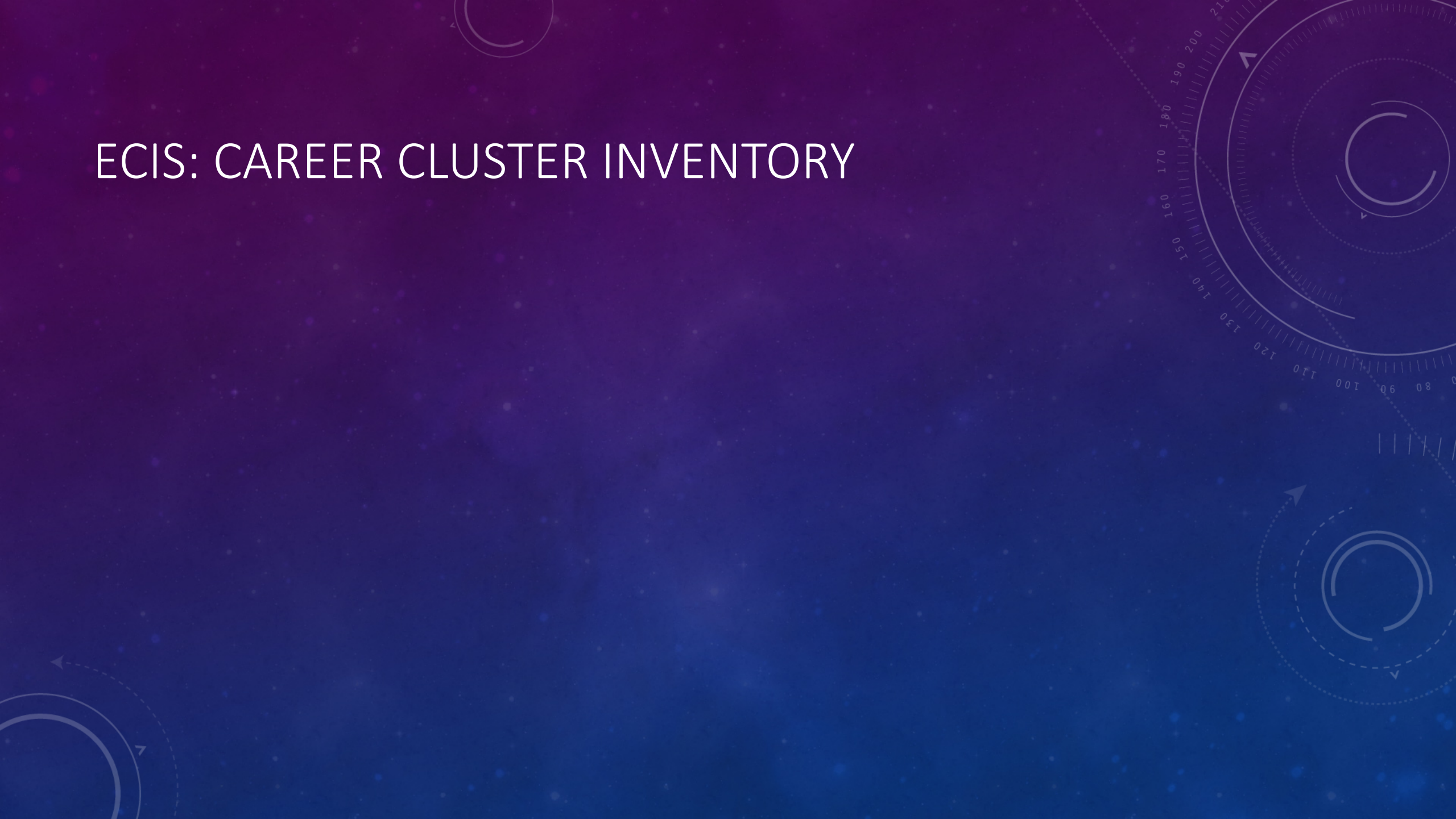

The pathways listed in the next topic give you more information about information technology.

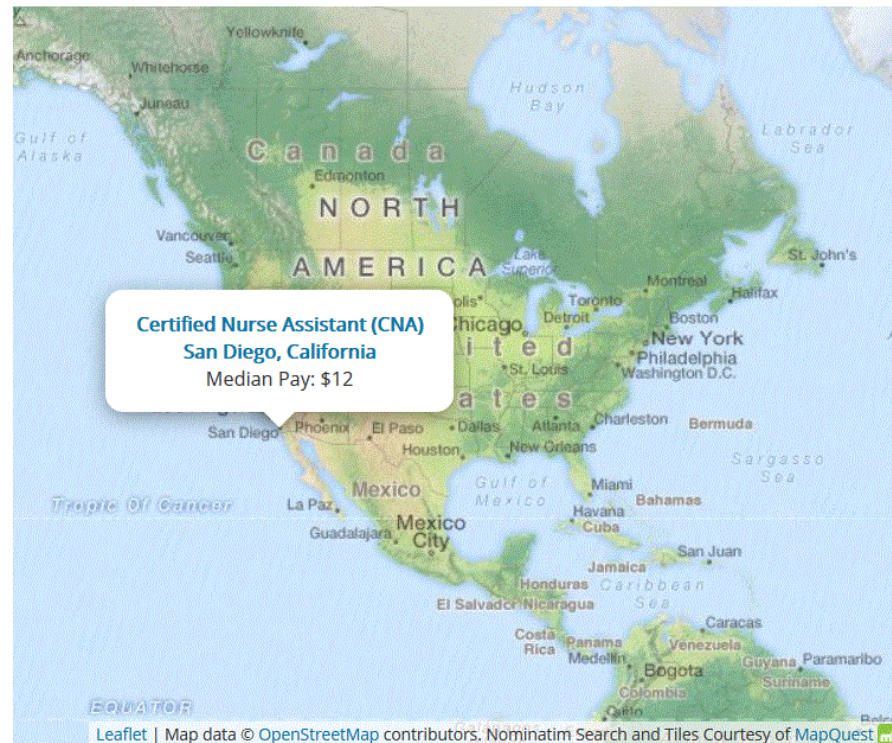
